Course Description

Enhance therapy outcomes in you pediatric clients by utilizing a combination of taping and strengthening techniques that will be presented in this course. You will practice with a variety of materials on other class participants. Strengthening strategies will be presented and practiced to enhance the new alignments through taping techniques. Examples of interventions with children through pictures, videotape, case reports will reinforce learning.

What will be covered:

- Theory and principles of taping as adjunct to therapy
- Kinesiotaping techniques for improved function
- Rigid strapping taping techniques for improved alignment
- Strengthening activities including utilization of traditional exercises, Pilates, Theraband and Swiss ball to be used in conjunction with presented taping techniques

- Identify underlying theory and basic principles of taping and strengthening for the treatment/management of posture and movement problems in children
- Identify strategies to improve posture and movement utilizing at least 3 different materials in upper extremities, lower extremities and trunk
- Demonstrate strengthening techniques to enhance carryover from learned taping techniques
